Title: What is the Church?

Text: Multiple

Big Idea: The Church is a diverse people who exist— *locally, globally, and eternally*—by the plan of the father, the work of the son, and the presence of the Spirit

Common Misconceptions About The Church

Is the Church a building? No!

Is the Church a movement? Maybe...

Is the Church a people? Yes!

Consequently, the Church is a diverse people who exist— *locally, globally, and eternally*—by the plan of the father, the work of the son, and the presence of the Spirit

Scriptural examples of a diverse people who exist locally, globally, and eternally...

1 Corinthians 12:12-14 | **To the church of God that is in Corinth...** For just as the body is one and has many members, and **all the members of the body, though many, are one body**, so it is with Christ. ¹³ For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body—**Jews or Greeks, slaves or free**—and all were made to drink of one Spirit. ¹⁴ For the body does not consist of one member but of many

Ephesians 2:19-22 | **To the saints who are in Ephesus...** ¹⁹ So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are **fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God**, ²⁰ built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus himself being the cornerstone, ²¹ in whom the whole structure, being joined together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord. ²² In him you also are being built together into **a dwelling place for God by the Spirit**.

Revelation 7:9-10 | **John to the seven churches that are in Asia...** After this I looked, and behold, **a great multitude** that no one could number, **from every nation, from all tribes and peoples and languages**, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, **clothed in white robes**, with palm branches in their hands, ¹⁰ and crying out with a loud voice, "Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!"

By the Plan of the Father...

Ephesians 1:3-6, 9-10— Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places, ⁴ even as he chose us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and blameless before him. In love ⁵ he predestined us for adoption to himself as sons through Jesus Christ, according to the purpose of his will, ⁶ to the praise of his glorious grace, with which he has blessed us in the Beloved...according to his purpose, which he set forth in Christ ¹⁰ as a plan for the fullness of time, to unite all things in him, things in heaven and things on earth.



Romans 8:29-30—For those whom he foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, in order that he might be the firstborn among many brothers. ³⁰ And those whom he predestined he also called, and those whom he called he also justified, and those whom he justified he also glorified.

By the Work of the Son

Matthew 5:17, Luke 24:27, & Galatians 4:4-5—Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I have not come to abolish them but to fulfill them. And beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, he interpreted to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning himself. But when the fullness of time had come, God sent forth his Son, born of woman, born under the law, ⁵ to redeem those who were under the law, so that we might receive adoption as sons.

1 Corinthians 15:3-5—For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, ⁴ that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures, ⁵ and that he appeared

Hebrews 7:23-25 & 1 John 2:1b—The former priests were many in number, because they were prevented by death from continuing in office, ²⁴ but he holds his priesthood permanently, because he continues forever. ²⁵ Consequently, he is able to save to the uttermost those who draw near to God through him, since he always lives to make intercession for them...But if anyone does sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous

By the Presence of the Spirit

John 16:12-15—I still have many things to say to you, but you cannot bear them now. ¹³ When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all the truth, for he will not speak on his own authority, but whatever he hears he will speak, and he will declare to you the things that are to come. ¹⁴ He will glorify me, for he will take what is mine and declare it to you. ¹⁵ All that the Father has is mine; therefore I said that he will take what is mine and declare it to you.

Ephesians 5:18-21—And do not get drunk with wine, for that is debauchery, but be filled with the Spirit, ¹⁹ addressing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody to the Lord with your heart, ²⁰ giving thanks always and for everything to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, ²¹ submitting to one another out of reverence for Christ

1 Corinthians 12:4-11—Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit; ⁵ and there are varieties of service, but the same Lord; ⁶ and there are varieties of activities, but it is the same God who empowers them all in everyone. ⁷ To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good. ⁸ For to one is given through the Spirit the utterance of wisdom, and to another the utterance of knowledge according to the same Spirit, ⁹ to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healing by the one Spirit, ¹⁰ to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another the ability to distinguish between spirits, to another various

kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues. **11** All these are empowered by one and the same Spirit, who apportions to each one individually as he wills.
