General Guidelines & Precautions

As we begin to gather again, please consider these following precautions and practices:

- ***6/25/20 Update*** Anyone 18 or older: Please wear a mask at our Sunday gatherings to follow the ordinance that began on Wednesday, 6/24/20. Exceptions would be:
 - Persons under 18, those already observing federal social distancing guidelines (the 6-foot rule), persons with pre-existing medical conditions that would be worsened by a mask, hearing-impaired persons, exercising, or religious rituals such as singing.
- If you've shown symptoms, such as a fever or a persistent cough within 24 hours of our Sunday gathering, please stay home.
- If someone in your home has shown similar symptoms within 24 hours of our Sunday gathering, please keep the whole family home.
- If you or someone in your household comes into contact with an individual who has tested positive for the coronavirus/COVID-19 OR if you or someone in your household has tested positive for the coronavirus/COVID-19, please inform the church as soon as possible. Also, we would ask that you'd follow the recommended CDC guidelines found [here](#) prior to returning to a Sunday gathering.

Arrival & Parking

Since we are sharing the building with SHCC, many cars will be coming and going as you arrive.

- Exercise the utmost caution in the parking lot which will be a busy place
- Try and arrive between 11:15-11:30 to give time for the SHCC members to clear the lot.
- Look for BCF impressions team members for direction and safety.
- If the lot is full there are grass spots behind the building, and street parking is available (regulated by signs)
- Families with younger children will need to keep their children near them in the building. Holding conversations outdoors will be the best way to connect.

Also, Please Take Note

- The doors will remain propped open from 11:00-11:30. The entrance will be manned if weather doesn't allow them to remain open.
- No coffee or food will be served. You are encouraged to bring your own coffee or water.
- Hand sanitizer, masks, and disinfectant wipes will be available upon request
- Gray buckets will be placed near the hospitality if you desire to give financially in person.
- Please avoid handshakes and hugs. Instead, consider exchanging warm words of greeting. Also, we will not hand out guest bags. Rather, as you greet our guests, point them to <https://baycitiesoldsmar.com/sundays>.
